

\$6 Million in Assets to Fuel County Growth

Funded by business contributions, grants and other resources in the county, the Daviess County Economic Development Foundation offers unique opportunities for real and lasting economic expansion and development.

Funding from the Foundation, coupled with a grant investment from the Indiana Economic Development Corporation (IEDC), made possible the design and construction of a 25,000 sq. ft. multi-use building in the WestGate @ Crane Technology Park. The new building, located immediately next to the \$2 billion Naval Surface Warfare Center (NSWC) at Crane, is home today to the NSWC commercial operations of EG&G, a subsidiary of the \$4.7 billion URS corporation. This Foundation investment literally jumpstarted new construction in the park, which today has more than 100,000 sq. ft. of new private development and the creation of more than 200 new high-paying technology jobs.



Olon Industries, a Canadian-based wood product manufacturer, operates its U.S. headquarters and chief manufacturing operations in Washington, the county seat. Through innovative funding arranged by the Daviess County Economic Development Foundation, Olon was able to lease all-new facilities and expand their national operations in the county.
